Candidates have until **14 January 2026** to submit their online application.

The College of Europe, established on the initiative of the Hague Congress, dates back to 1949 and is the oldest postgraduate institute of European studies. The founding idea was to establish an institute where university graduates from many different European countries could study and live together in preparation for international careers.

Our long-lasting mission at the College of Europe in Natolin has always been to prepare our students to think beyond disciplinary boundaries, beyond preconceptions, and to encourage them to build bridges and embrace a wider perspective on Europe.

The College of Europe in Natolin invites candidates to apply for the **Advanced Master of Arts in European Interdisciplinary Studies** featuring:

Each year, Natolin hosts over 120 students from more than 30 different countries, who learn to view Europe from a broader perspective.

Every year, more than **70% of College of Europe students are granted partial or full scholarships** by their government, the private sector or the College of Europe itself thanks to the support of EU institutions.
